- Students will be dismissed at 2.45pm.

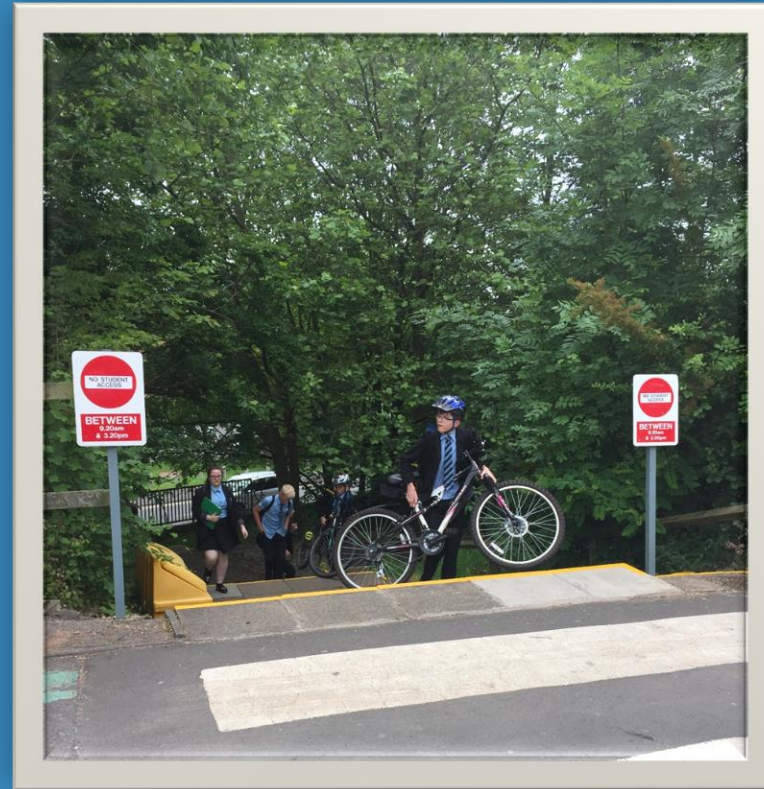
