

16-19 Tuition Fund

The Government has introduced the 16 to 19 tuition fund which is a £96 million of one-off funding for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

Our share of this funding is £2,546.

The guidance related to the fund means that:

- Only students who do not have 4-9 passes in either or both English and Maths GCSE at the end of KS4 can be supported by this fund.
- The Fund is not limited to supporting GCSE Maths and English but can be for any aim in the learner's programme of study

The fund will be used to provide:

- small group tuition for sixth form students who have not yet achieved a grade 5 or above in English and/or maths.
- Careers Information Advice and Guidance from the Sixth Form Team and our Careers Advisor
- The impact of these sessions will be monitored based on student performance and progress in their courses and their preparation for and confidence in applying to future destinations, including higher education, employment and apprenticeships.
