



## Holiday Homework (Superhero)

You will need to bring this homework to your first English lesson at Droitwich Spa High School. If you don't end up having an English lesson on your first day, you can leave this project in your tutor room.

In your English lessons, you will have created your own superhero. Your homework is to design an appropriate costume for your superhero. The costume should be designed to represent your superhero's personality traits, as well as their heritage and powers.

You could undertake this task in any of the following ways:

- Draw your outfit and label it
- Create it from papier-mâché
- Create a miniature model of your outfit using whichever materials you desire
- Create a life-size model of your outfit using whichever materials you desire

You must also justify your decisions regarding the costume in writing. This must be at least 200 words and should describe the superhero and their powers/personality traits. There must then be a description of the outfit and accessories, with an explanation of how this represents the superhero's powers or personality traits.

### An exemplar paragraph:

Thor's steel suit of armour is designed to symbolise his strength and power, along with showing that he is constantly prepared for battle. Furthermore, his boots are rather elaborate and showy, designed to show his readiness for any situation but also to imply a sense of vanity due to their magnificence.

Typically, superheroes often wear capes, so I have designed one for Thor to show that he is the typical hero who would sacrifice himself for others.

Additionally, the burgundy colour is used to represent the fact that he can be quite reckless and dangerous.
