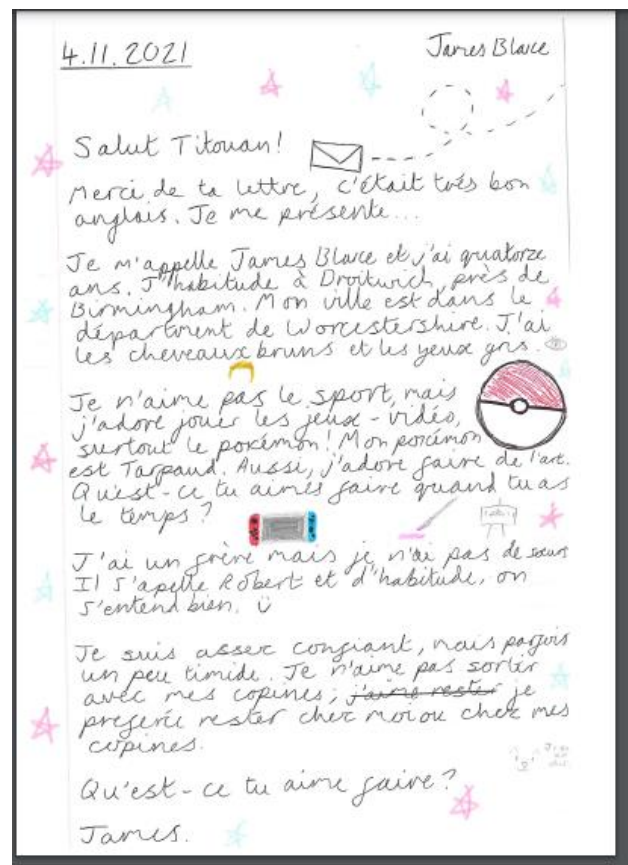
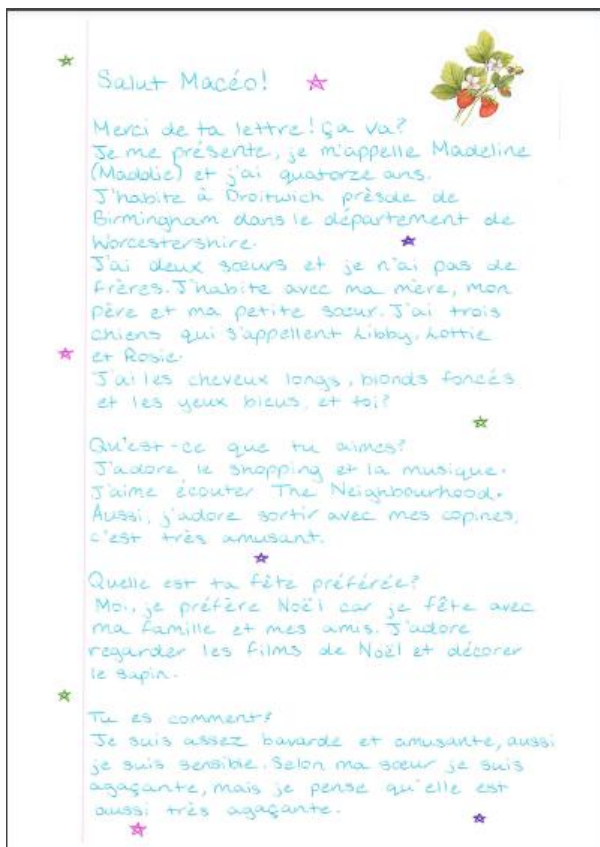

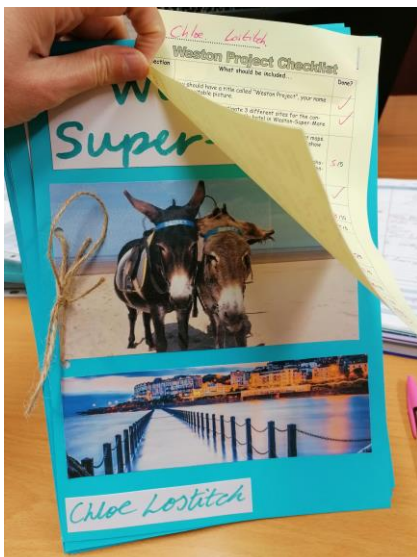
Year 9
